*The first impression on the nose is marked by great intensity. She is opening on biscuit, mature wheat, pear and cherry flavour. After a few seconds, the nose became wider. The iris, oak, celery, white pepper and fine mineral aromas bring depth and complexity to the wine. With air, melted butter and toast notes appear, reflecting an harmonious evolution of the wine.*

*This wine develops aromas of intense red fruits, including wild strawberries, wild raspberries, cherries and gooseberries. After a few minutes of aeration, a light floral fragrance awakens our senses with notes of linden and lilac.*

*On the palate, the attack of red fruits is predominant and supported by the freshness of pink grapefruit. Delicate flavours of melon and vine peach enliven our taste buds during the tasting. The whole makes us discover a wine of great freshness, ample and very balanced.*

Waipara West Sauvignon Blanc 2020  
Canterbury, New Zealand

\$ 75.00

*Aromas of beachy grasses, pure lime blossom and spicy thai basil supported by fuller depths of lychee and crunchy white peach. A complex yet concise palate of juicy green granny smith apple, Sauvignon Blanc purity, river gravels and sea salt. Bright and vibrant acidity powers this wine of precision and drive.*



Orin Swift Mannequin 2018 (Chardonnay)  
California, USA

\$ 95.00

*A lurid straw gold, the aromatics abound with bright lemon, butterscotch, honeysuckle and jasmine, with hints of Granny Smith apple, fresh butter and lime zest. Rich and layered upon entry, the palate espouses honeydew, yellow peach, vanilla with a lush, weighty viscosity. A vein of acidity is present through the finish with a pleasing close of minerality and lemon pith.*

Domaine Albert Mann  
Riesling Cuvee Albert 2018  
Alsace, France

\$ 94.00

*Grapes for the Albert cuvée are grown on varied soils of gravel, clay, limestone and granite. Its intense aromatic bouquet expresses notes of citrus fruits. On the palate, the same delicious notes of yellow fruits are present. There is a certain salinity and, on the whole, a great persistence. Enjoy this wine with seafood.*

Bourgogne Chardonnay 2017  
Burgundy, France

*Pale yellow in color with hints of gold, with citrusy but subtly vanilla aromas on the nose, this Chardonnay's generous palate offers notes of marzipan and Acacia honey. The finish is fresh and mouthwatering.*

*Red -uit aromas, with cedar and boldo notes. On the palate it is -esh and -uity, with flavors of cherry and hints of pepper and rosemary. Silky, with velvety tannins and great mouthfeel.*

### Beronia Gran Reserva 2012 Rioja, Spain

\$ 88.00

*Beronia Gran Reserva 2012 is a very deep garnet colour. On the nose it displays a vast array of aromas, from stewed ripe fruit to prunes and nuts such as walnuts. Subtle hints of tobacco and powdered cacao also come through, together with white pepper and balsamic notes that add freshness. It delivers distinct notes of fruit and nuts on the palate, which provide structure and tannin. The wine is long, very complex, balanced and also sophisticated.*

*On the nose, hints of pepper, especially pink pepper, and calcareous notes predominate, while on the mouth the austerity and grainy texture stand out. Incomparably long finish and great definition. When first smelt, it can be perceived as shy or tight, so decanting is recommended.*

*A complex nose of dark cherry and blackberry aromas with a hint of forest floor and spice  
Palate: Vibrant dark cherry and blackberry with a hint of 'wombat rolled in all spice' balanced with an even, textural palate with soft, supple tannins*

Tenuta Sant'Antonio Castagnedi Amarone \$ 108.00  
Della Vapolicella 2016  
Verona, Italy

*Characterised by a deep ruby red colour with a subtle purple hue, the wine opens deliciously with aromas of ripe red fruit, accompanied by notes of liquorice, black pepper and chocolate. Now that it's spent a bit of time in the bottle, the body has had a chance to develop and be well-balanced with silky tannins.*

Orin Swift 8 Years in the Desert 2019 \$ 108.00  
California, USA

*Evolving aromatics present themselves first with black and white pepper, then a ripe fruit core of brambly raspberry and sweet persimmon, finishing with savory notes of allspice, clove and fig leaf. Boisterous yet elegant on entry, the wine shows its plush layers with distinctive strawberry preserves, blackberry and raspberry pie topped with fresh crème. Round, ripe tannins close the palate menacingly with well-integrated acidity and enduring energy. Varietal: Zinfandel, Syrah, Petite Sirah*

*A blend of 60% Grenache and 40% Syrah, this luscious red drenches the palate with sun-kissed plum and cassis flavors. Decadent and creamy, it juxtaposes pristine black fruit against swirls of vanilla, licorice and cacao. Fine, soft tannins make it approachable already but it's likely to gain complexity*



Château Beychevelle  
Amiral de Beychevelle 2017  
Bordeaux, France

\$ 120.00

*Soft, elegant and fruity with excellent depth and breed. With Amiral, the objective is to make a wine which can be drunk earlier than the Grand Vin (with more Merlot).*

Podere Le Ripi Amore e Magia  
Brunello di Montalcino DOCG 2016  
Tuscany, Italy

\$ 180.00

*A deep ruby red, richer when compared to wines from our other vineyards. In the nose it expresses itself as a symphony of aromas going from the intense smell of red orange and violet to the fresh balsamic note of herbs. This vineyard is characterized by a more creamy and silky taste coupled with a fun and vibrant saltiness.*

Clos Marey-Monge 75 Rangs  
Burgundy, France

\$ 200.00

*With its bright and intense ruby colour lined with crimson reflections, our Clos Marey-Monge Monopole 2016 is a complex, generous and flavourful Pinot Noir. The nose shows aromas of powder and red fruits, as well as notes of smokiness, all bringing great complexity to the wine. The palate is fresh, revealing firm tannins and a well-rounded structure. Long and sapid while aerial, the finale unveils a vibrant, energetic, and complex Pommard drinkable today, but also age-able for decades.*
