After more than six years of aging in the cellar, this cuvée embodies the elegance of great Chardonnays whereby the chalky terroir of the Côte des Blancs imparts remarkable minerality and freshness. Combined with those from the Grand Cru villages, benefitting from a unique microclimate that enhances the Chardonnay's roundness, elevates its fruity aromas, and reveals a creamy texture. Enriched with reserve wines, this cuvée stands out for its depth and complexity, magnified by the passage of time.

A vibrant, mineral-driven Chardonnay with notes of citrus, stone fruit, white flowers, saline drive, and a silky mineral core. Its elegant finish is highlighted by limestone minerality. Enjoy on its own or paired with seafood.

Highly elegant with nose opening of fresh notes of citrus, green apple, and white peach, accompanied by floral nuances and hints of dried fruit and butter. On the palate, it is fresh and lively, with a lovely acidity that balances with a creamy texture and a long, lingering mineral finish.

Château de Pommard, Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2022 Burgundy, France

Fresh red fruit (cherry, raspberry) and woody notes with vanilla hints on the nose, a silky palate with good volume, revealing a long finish enhanced by a well-balanced tannic structure, perfect to enjoy now or cellar for up to 10 years.

Château de Pommard, Clos Marey-Monge "Vivant-Micault" 2022 Burgundy, France

\$128

A pure expression of a minimally oaked Pinot Noir, this wine displays a deep ruby color. This refreshing and elegant wine features aromas of red fruits, such as redcurrant and cherry, with a hint of spice. On the palate, the tannins are ethereal and lacy, and explodes in the mouth with its jubilant, juicy Morello cherry profile.

Château de Pommard, Volnay Premier Cru 2015 Burgundy, France

An elegant blend of two Premier Cru parcels in producing of this finely balanced and delicate Pinot Noir. It is the perfume of ripe red fruits and aromatic herbs that really holds your attention at first, echoed on the palate too. The texture is dense with tannins which will soften and express more complexity and balance with time.

Guillaume Gonnet, Le Mentor Gigondas 2023 Rhône, France

Dark fruit, plum, blueberry, blackberries, liquorice, raisin, slight earthy and herbal notes coming through with a hint of black pepper. This wine is bold and rich, whilst retaining a beautiful balance on the palate.

Brilliantly elegant, pure, and a flawlessly balanced style. Giving up ripe black cherry, currants, tobacco leaf, and spicy oak, with textbook Graves scorched earth, it hits the palate with medium to full-bodied richness, a beautiful layered, seamless mouthfeel, great tannins, and one heck of a great finish

Amiral de Beychevelle 2021
(2nd Wine of Chateau Beychevelle, 4th Growth)

The expressive nose seduces with its floral fragrances, wherein notes of violet dominate. The beautifully fresh palate seduces with its powerful and silky tannins as well as its union of fruity (red fruits) and spicy aromas.

Bordeaux, France

Elegant, classic style with notes of blackcurrant, plum, roses, and spice, showing a fine texture and balanced tannins from a challenging vintage. Well praised for its finesse, fruit purity, and aging potential, offering a complex bouquet and a persistent, mineral finish.

Known for its fresh, citrusy, floral notes (elderflower, peach blossom, chamomile) with spicy hints (curry, pepper) and a minerality from its volcanic terroir, offering juicy fruit and bright acidity, making it a versatile pairing for antipasti, fish, and white meats.

Tenuta Sant'Antonio, Amarone Della Valpolicella Antonio Castagnedi 2019 Veneto, Italy

Rich aromas of ripe cherries, plum, spice (pepper, liquorice), and chocolate, with a full-bodied, velvety palate, soft tannins, and a long, elegant finish and a savoury finish, perfect for rich meats or meditation.

Arnaldo Rivera, Barolo DOCG Undicicomuni 2019 Piedmont, Italy

Spiced cedar, leather, and scorched earth on the nose. The palate is wild and savoury with notes of crushed raspberry, figs, cinnamon, star anise alongside velvety dusty tannins and fresh acidity.

Riecine, La Gioia, IGT 2021 (Super Tuscan) Tuscany, Italy

A muscular wine with aromas of dried cherries, raspberries, tobacco, and earth. Medium- to full-bodied, it displays firm, velvety tannins, and crisp acidity with a tight finish.

With classic Marlborough zest and lift, this wine displays the scents of spring with notes of white blossom, citrus and lemon sherbet. Citrus and passionfruit flavours with a full flavoured middle from concentrated fruit with the distinctive Rapaura flinty and mineral finish.

Ripe plums, sweet spice notes of nutmeg and clove and a hint of balsamic. On the palate, black fruits blend with cacao and cedar notes, finishing with layers of smooth spice. This is a full-bodied with silky tannins and a long, smooth finish.

Levantine Hill, Estate Range Syrah 2019

Yarra Valley, Australia

Elegant and complex, and a balance of rich dark fruits with savoury notes of pepper, spice, smoked meats, and minerals, offering a plush yet poised palate, silky tannins, and potential for aging. It's a medium-bodied red with depth, fine structure, and a long, savoury finish, ideal with duck, lamb, or eggplant dishes, and suitable for vegans.

Orin Swift Abstract 2021

California, USA

Opening aromas of muddled blue and blackberries with a frame of dark chocolate brownie and seasoned leather. The wine enters with class, being soft and lush, with notes of ripe plum, and boysenberry. Grippy, chewy tannins, the wine closes with pleasing sarsaparilla and blackcurrant.
